



On Friday, 24th October 2014, Professor Svetlana Petukhova, will present a seminar on **Business Education Development in Siberia** at REGENT Business School's Brown Bag Seminar Series titled **Issues in Critical Management Studies**. We are hopeful that Professor Petukhova will also allude to the question of BRICS in her seminar presentation, especially given that Russia is a critical member of the new global political bloc.







According to Dr. Svetlana Petukhova, Novosibirsk is a major fast-growing and young city and is the non-official capital of Siberia with a population of about 1, 5 million people. It is the third largest city in Russia. Novosibirsk is considered as the most prestigious city for life and business development. Moreover, it is a major industrial city, which comprises various parts of industry from assembling aircrafts to mining. Logistics and education services also play a significant role in the city's development.

In terms of business development, Novosibirsk is the leading city in Siberia and the far eastern regions of Russia. The city makes a great impact on demand for management and first-time entrepreneurs. In this respect, Novosibirsk State University provides the main business education programmess, which cover the areas of economics and management. The business executive education programmes are also attractive to professionals who aspire to make a business, a career.
