The China study tour is a collaboration between the Management College of Southern Africa (MANCOSA), Regent Business School (RBS) and the Shanghai University of International Business and Economics (SUIBE). This experiential tour will make the city, the railway system, the restaurants, the streets, the infrastructure and taxis of Shanghai expand the minds and perspectives of delegates, thereby becoming their classroom. The delegate's learning will be transformed and they will be able to correlate the different methods of consumer lifestyles, cultures, the importance of business management, project planning and particularly logistics and passenger transportation in making business happen.

COST

The price excludes home country in-land transportation, required immunizations, personal expenses, optional cultural events and sight-seeing.
