

WORK-DIRECTED LEARNING (WDL) INTEGRATION PROJECT

Transversal skill integration, which includes communication, creativity, collaboration, critical thinking, to name a few, has emerged as a pivotal strategy to enhance employability skills. At REGENT Business School (RBS), transversal skills are integrated through active learning strategies, project-based learning, and real-world applications in the curricula to skill, upskill and reskill our students. The term Work Directed Learning (WDL) is used at RBS which is predominantly embedded in the curricula. This method cultivates students' capacity to adapt, invent, and work productively in a variety of contexts in addition to providing them with academic knowledge. Moreover, it fosters holistic development, as students gain self-confidence, resilience, and a broader perspective on complex issues. The Work Directed Learning components are introduced as a structured educational strategy that integrates "classroom" study with practical work experience in the field that is relevant to the students' programme outcomes/academic goals. This will allow students to apply their technical knowledge to real-world problems while also giving them an understanding of normal organisational culture, human connections, and working conditions.

iLeadLAB

REGENT Business School's iLeadLAB is an academic makerspace that provides students with a hands-on and innovative learning experience. iLeadLAB uses technology, prototyping, and maker-centred learning approaches that encourages students to develop 21st-century skills and competencies that are essential for success in a 41R workplace. iLeadLAB trains students in laser cutting, sublimation, web development, and social media marketing. iLeadLAB also offers an Introduction to Robotic Process Automation program for students. By exposing students to makerspaces and other innovative learning opportunities, the iLeadLAB is helping to bridge the skills gap and prepare students for the rapidly changing job market.



redHUB

REGENT Business School's redHUB promotes entrepreneurship for students looking to launch their own businesses through Work Directed Learning (WDL) approaches that focuses on solving real world problems. By incorporating entrepreneurship training into the WDL approach, students are given the tools and resources they need to be adaptable, innovative, and successful in their entrepreneurship pursuit.

redHUB drives the Higher Certificate in Entrepreneurship programme at RBS in three ways: i) The Start-Up Challenge, ii) Collaboration with iLeadLAB and iii) Shark Tank. Each of these elements challenge our students to get to demonstrate their entrepreneurship skills. redHUB is helping students to demystify the process of starting a business by providing practical case-based training for would-be entrepreneurs, and valuable guidance on the critical steps involved. For early-stage entrepreneurs, the just-in-time short courses are a valuable resource for improving business strategy, organization, and performance.



Business Visits

In the beginning of the year students who attend tutorials on campus were afforded the opportunity to meet and interact with entrepreneurs based close to campus. This allowed the students to get first-hand information about the successes as well as challenges faced by 'real entrepreneurs'. The meeting with these entrepreneurs gave them insights into what it really takes for small businesses to succeed and the bittersweet taste of success which comes after years of hard work. The aim of this event, the business excursion, was to allow students access to entrepreneurs in the place of their businesses to gain the stated benefits.



The Market Day Pitch Training

Held at all three main campuses, this event allowed students studying the Higher Certificate in Business Management an opportunity to put their classroom gained skills into practice with regards to costing, bookkeeping and sales specifically. Students were allowed the freedom to sell whatever they wanted as long as it was legal and not in bad taste. Students indicated that the lessons learnt were invaluable and therefore another such event was scheduled for later the same year. Lessons learnt also included doing some market research before the launch of the event and the need for more marketing.

A Pitch Training event was also held in partnership with SEDA (Small Enterprise Development Agency) over two days and was open to any student willing to attend. This event allowed students to put into practice what they have learnt regarding the main components of a business plan in the form of a business pitch. The student who excelled in this event was given a R15 000 voucher by SEDA towards the development of his business plan and the top 5 students were allowed to participate in the national pitch competition. A typical business pitch would cover aspects such as business opportunity, market research, finances, and strategy among others.
